Dear Parents and Carers,

Following on from the [homelearning letter](#) sent out on 12th September, please see the information below which explains how to access homelearning spellings and maths tasks set by the class teachers.

As a school, we use a QR code login and an emoji password solution for pupils called 'MyLogin'. This was introduced last academic year and pupils use it to log onto the computers at school and can also use this at home. Pupils in Years 1, 2 & 3 use a QR code and Year 4 use an emoji password. Children in Years 1 - 4 will be bringing their MyLogin codes home today to enable them to access these resources from home. Please be aware that there will be some platforms in the MyLogin section that pupils have not used yet.

To use the MyLogin web application successfully, please click [here](#) for the parent information guide.

Simply head to app.mylogin.com and search for Merley First School and use the QR code or emoji password we have provided you with.

When you enter the web address for MyLogin, you should then be presented with options. Select the relevant option (e.g. QR or Emojis) and enter the given password which we have provided. Any QR codes from last year should be the same as the ones for this year, with the exception of Year 4 pupils who now need to transition to using the emoji passwords.

Once you log in, you may also notice different applications that are used in school. These can also be explored at home but may not initially be familiar to the children.

For now, the only homelearning set is spelling in Google classroom but from October, Times Table Rockstarts and Numbots homework will be set.

If you have any questions about using MyLogin once your child has their code, please direct them to the office and I will do my best to answer them and seek further information/support from the IT team if needed.
