We will be learning...

Autumn Celebrations

We will think about the changes that the new season brings (light and dark) and what changes we need to make eg: warmer clothes, reflective clothes.
We will think about Autumn as part of the yearly cycle of 4 seasons.
We will explore Autumn colours through colour mixing to paint our own Autumn trees.



Uses our Senses

We will be using our senses to find out about Autumn.
We will go on an Autumn walk around the school noticing the physical changes we can see all around us and will use magnifying glasses to investigate what we find.
