The children all enjoyed watching the kite fly on a windy afternoon.



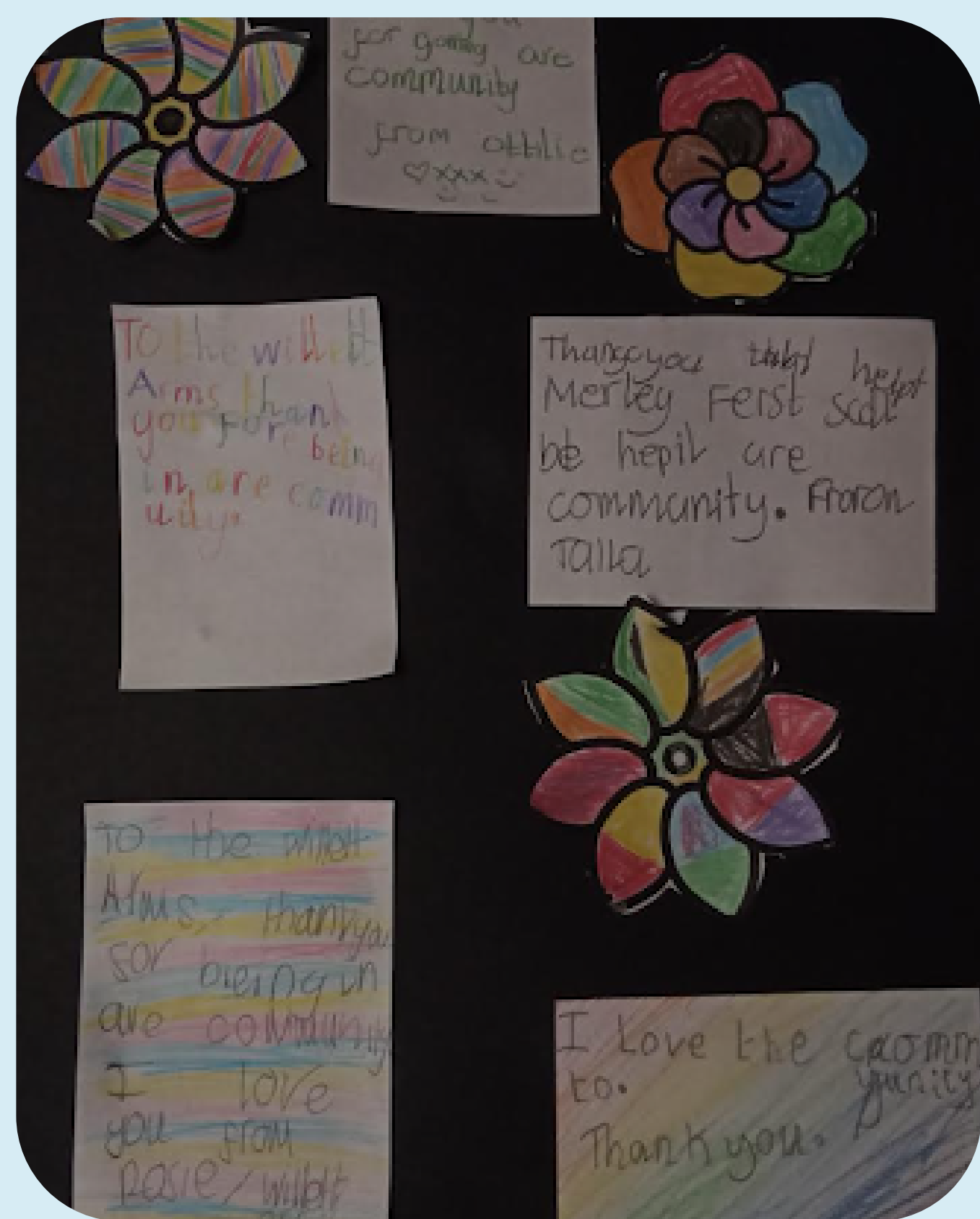
Year 1
