We loved talking to our adult on the school phone.

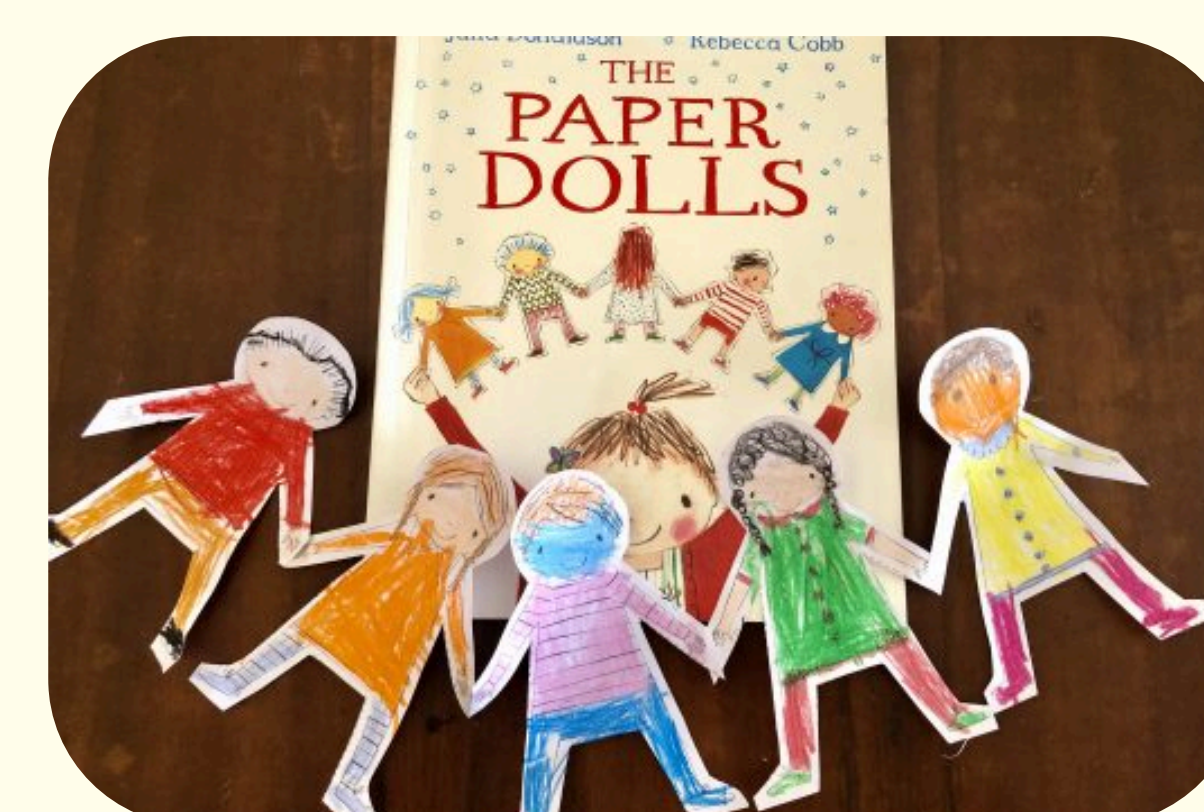
We enjoyed the awe and wonder of blowing as many bubbles as we could and loved watching where the wind blew them!
